Instructions for arriving by Car to St. Cuthbert's Society Catered accommodation

Special arrangements and a one-way-system are in place on Sunday 27th September so that you can drive to your accommodation on either North or South Bailey to drop off items.

This information is only relevant if you are living in Catered accommodation.

Do not drive directly to St. Cuthbert's Society when you arrive in Durham.

The time slot you have booked is when you should collect your permit (Step 1 below), not the time you arrive at your accommodation.

A map is available on Pages 3 and 4 showing the one-way system as reference.

Please follow these steps -

1. Drive to the '**Maths and Computer Sciences Building**', Upper Mountjoy Campus, Stockton Road, DH1 3LE **at your booked time slot.**

 - Please ensure to arrive via the Stockton Road entrance to help with traffic management
2. Park as directed by the University stewards and security on duty.
3. Once parked in the holding area, we recommend that only one person from your party go to collect a permit, allowing you to access the Peninsula area, where St. Cuthbert's Catered accommodation is based.
4. Please return to your vehicle as soon as you have been given your access permit, you will then be directed to the relevant queue for your college. Security will then send vehicles up in order of college time slot.

5. You will be directed to your accommodation. College representatives will help unload the Car and move things into your room as you visit Reception (12 South Bailey) to collect your Key, Campus Card, and Welcome information.
6. You will have 15 minutes to unload your car, after 15 minutes you will need to remove your vehicle immediately. Please follow the one-way system off the Peninsula and across Prebends Bridge.
7. The University has made provision for free parking on the Mountjoy site, first come first served, should you wish to use this after your allocated College drop-off slot. After crossing Prebends Bridge, turn left onto Quarryheads Lane, cross the roundabout, and go straight onto Stockton Road. You can then enter the Mountjoy site via the entrance on the right. 8. Please display the permit clearly in the car windscreen whilst on the Peninsula and in the University car park.
9. Once you have parked at this location off the Peninsula, you (and your guardians) will have all the time you wish to look around the city. Please note that if you use a public car park, you must purchase a pay and display ticket or use the PayByPhone app.
