Common Awards T3: Programme regulations 2024–25

Certificate of Higher Education in Christian Ministry and Mission (180 Credits)

- 1. This programme is available at the Scottish Episcopal Institute in a full-time or part-time mode of study.
- 2. Candidates shall study a minimum of 90 and a maximum of 120 credits at Level 4 and a minimum of 60 and a maximum of 90 credits at Level 5 for a total of 180 credits.
- 3. Candidates shall negotiate their choice of modules with the Director of Studies in light of the ministry for which they are preparing or in which they already serve and according to module availability in any year of study.
- 4. Modules which appear in more than one list may only be taken once.
