T3: Programme Regulations 2024-25

Diploma in Theology, Ministry and Mission (240 Credits)

• This programme is available at St Mellitus College, in Part-time or Full-time mode of study, and is relevant to students who started the programme in part-time mode from September 2023, and students who start the programme in full-time mode from September 2024. Students who start the part-time programme in September 2024 will be offered 60 credits in the current curriculum and 180 credits from the new level 4 curriculum starting in September 2025 and the new level 5 curriculum starting in September 2026 which will fulfil the programme specifications for Common Awards.

This programme is offered in-person across our centres with the following exceptions:

• TMM1067, TMM1087, TMM2107 and TMM2097 will be delivered online at all centres to allow students from all centres to study together.
