

St Stephen's House Common Awards

T3: Programme Regulations 2024-25

MA Theology, Ministry and Mission (180 Credits)

This programme is available at **St Stephen's House, Oxford**, in part-time mode of study over two years; it is intended for full time ordinands as part of their ministerial formation, and for eligible candidates who have obtained or fulfilled the requirements for the PGDip and who wish to complete the MA part-time. Some modules may be delivered online, or in a blend of online and in-person teaching. Any decision to deliver some or all of a module online will be taken in consultation with the relevant tutor(s) and all students scheduled to take it. Consultation will begin at least six weeks before the start of teaching, and will include consideration of factors, such as demand, numbers, the situations of those involved and wider circumstances. A decision to deliver some or all of a module online will be published at least four weeks before the module commences. It is expected that ordinands in residential training at St Stephen's House will be able to receive in-person tuition for at least 50% of their overall credits.
