

BA (Hons) in Theology, Ministry and Mission

1. This programme is available at **SWMTC** in part time mode of study and is designed for ordinands to take their studies to level 6 during their curacy years, completing in six years. Ordinands on a three-year training programme follow the M pathway. Those who study independently for a year before being accepted onto a three-year training pathway follow H. A third route (I) is available for those who remain as independent students. Some ordinand students, for example those with APL when embarking on training, may study at level 6 alongside their completion of level 5 modules. At level 6, each student must complete either TMM3362 or TMM3352. Level 6 modules TMM3487 and TMM3491 run each year and a selection of the other Level 6 modules are run subject to numbers of students and staff availability; the College will ensure that a minimum of 90 credits' worth of level 6 modules will be delivered over each 3 year period. Modules may appear in more than one list but can only be studied once. Compulsory modules are as shown below ('ALL' means it is compulsory for all pathways; modules not listed for a pathway are optional for it); other modules should be chosen in conversation with the Academic Registrar as timetable permits. In some circumstances, Independent students may also be able to study for a BA using a selection of these modules.
2. Most of these modules are taught through a blend of face-to-face classes (in person or on zoom) supported to varying extents by small groups meeting for reflective practice seminars; those marked * also have a significant amount of supported online learning, both synchronous and asynchronous. The exceptions are the Independent Learning Projects and Dissertation/Extended Learning Project, which are supervised in person or by zoom, and those modules marked ** which are entirely supported learning online, although some elements may be synchronous.
