1. This programme is available at The Queen's Foundation in full-time and part-time mode of study.
2. The programme is also available by digital learning mode.
3. The regulations pertain to academic year 2024-25.

The Graduate Certificate exists to support the formational development of students' study with the Foundation and in so doing the Foundation will always seek to avoid repetition of topics so that the student benefits most from this programme. For instance, a student who has completed the module Christian Theology Ritual and Pastoral Care at level 5 as part of a different award will not complete the same version of this module at level 6. The Foundation will also take account of combinations that are specifically excluded in the programme specification and would not for instance (and as indicated below) allow a combination of TMM3057 with TMM2087.
5. Candidates shall study and be assessed from optional modules List A to a total value of 60 credits:
 - TMM3011 and 3031 are an excluded combination and may not be taken together.
