#### **Overview**

The Faculty of Science offers SCOPE Doctoral Studentships for October 2026 entry. These studentships aim to attract outstanding candidates to pursue PhD research aligned with EPSRC funding priorities. The scheme supports global talent and fosters an inclusive research culture.

2 weeks from offer	Students are expected to confirm acceptance within 2 weeks of receipt of an offer of funding.

## **Eligibility Criteria**

- Applied to a full-time PhD programme at Durham University, and eligible for a place
  without concessions (except for degrees you are still completing between now and the
  PhD start date). This requirement includes meeting the Durham University's current
  English language requirements.
- Hold an excellent academic record (preferably MSc/MEng and first-class honours).
- Evidence of awards, publications, or research contributions.
- Excellent research proposal with societal impact.
- Commitment to professional conduct and adherence to EDI policy.
- Not currently enrolled in a doctoral programme, have studied for over 12 months on a doctoral programme or previously awarded a PhD.
- Not currently applying for other UKRI or university funded studentship related to their PhD studies at Durham University. (Note this does not include CSC-Durham award, which you may apply for in parallel).

## **Funding Details**

#### Each studentship covers:

- Stipend at UKRI agreed level.
- Payment of tuition fees (Home or International rate).
- Research Training Support Grant (RTSG) provision by departments (covering training, consumables and access to analytical facilities).

#### **Application Requirements (Main)**

- Durham University application number.
- Confirmation of eligibility (including English language & degree).
- CV (max 2 pages, PDF).
- Brief research proposal (max 300 words + 1 figure as PDF).
- Strategic fit statement (max 200 words).
- Supervisory team statement (max 150 words).
- Letter of support (PDF, if collaborative studentship with external partner).

Examples for the last name "Fulhame" might be: N4W241571\_Fulhame\_CV\_1.pdf, N4W241571\_Fulhame\_Figure\_1.pdf and/or N4W241571\_Fulhame\_LoS\_1.pdf.

If you spot a mistake after uploading but before completing this MS form, you can upload a copy with a higher version number - e.g. N4W241571\_Fulhame\_CV\_2.pdf - we will assume the file with the highest number at the end is the correct one to consider.
