### Call for papers

Students are invited to formulate a research question comprising, but not restricted to, one of the following subthemes:

- Translation in the sense of how one translates (in its broadest meaning) the experience of a foreign culture to their own understanding;
- how one can verbalize or draw meaning from a language experience;
- how worldviews translate or shift across different cultures.

Each group will have the opportunity to submit a grant proposal of up to £200 to support their research.

Please submit abstracts in English of up to 300 words indicating the format your contribution will take (paper, round-table, poster,...) and your preferred language to present in (English welcome) along with a short bio at:

Should participants be applying for a grant, 300 further words should be allocated to explaining the rationale for the grant alongside a breakdown of how the resources will be spent.
