Rivers of Ink brings a new light and sound projection to your area. The artwork uses the Codex Amiatinus, the world's oldest complete Bible, as a unique lens with which to look into the past. At turn of the eighth century the Northumbrian monks transformed the separate volumes of scriptural books into one all-encompassing book: the Bible as we know it today. Codex Amiatinus is not widely known in the region of its birth, but we hope to change that and to increase appreciation of this great Northumbrian book!
