

- International undergraduate students Sophomore or higher standing at home university with an strong academic transcript (GPA 3.0)
- High level of English language proficiency: TOEFL iBT 90+ / IELTS 7.0+ /
  Duolingo English Test 115+
- Exceptional motivation, emotional maturity, and a high aptitude for adapting to new environments
